(p. 64) "Reasoning can scarcely be separated from the thinking...We consider abstract ideas and symbols, and manipulate them into poems, mathematical formulae, musical scores..., political speeches. We make decisions, we set goals, and...we organize, research, and plan; We solve problems...We decide that information which we had learned in the past is pertinent to our present...We select, compile,..., compare, contrast, classify, name, count, estimate, and calculate...We reason, we induce, deduce, infer, generalize, specify, recognize similarities, and draw analogies...We...argue endlessly about what is true, good, right, beautiful, and just...and what is not...."(p. 64).

Holy Bible, Philippians 4 13 of The Holy Bible.

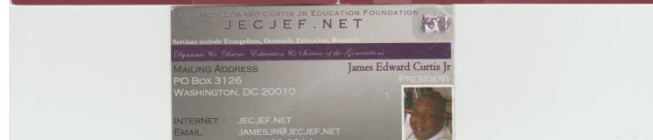
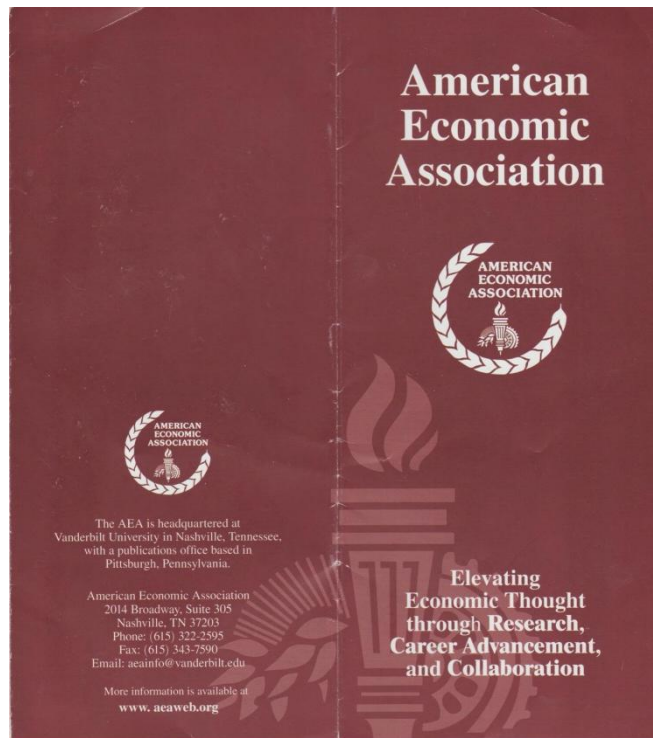


Exhibit-1: American Economic Association Brochure

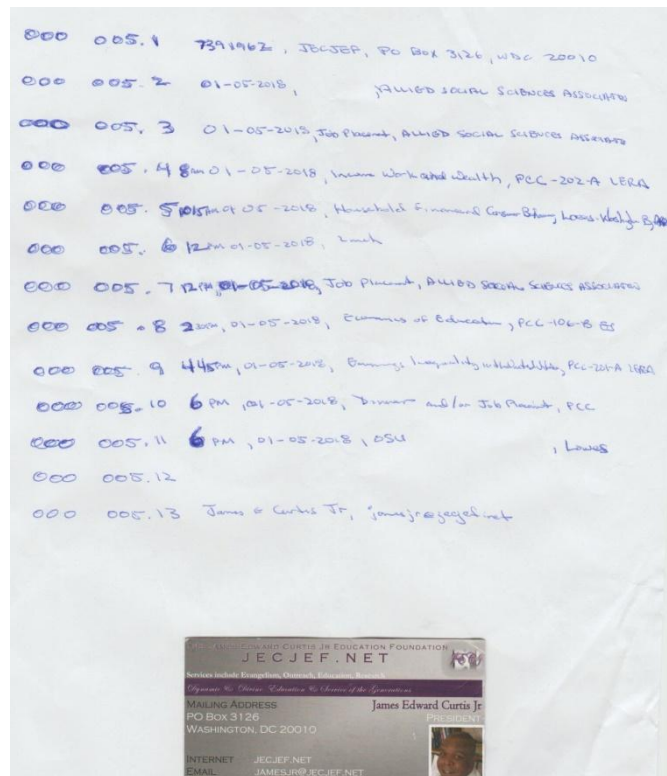
